**ORDER**

Filed before this court is a verified Petition dated October 17, 2024, that alleges among others that, petitioner Gina Clemente Delos Santos, is of legal age, married, Filipino citizen, and a resident of 1 Progreso St., Barangay 4, San Jose, Antique, and temporarily residing at 10701 Vista Del Sol Dr, El Paso, TX 79935, USA. She is represented in the Petition by Alex Clemente Delos Santos, of legal age, single, Filipino citizen, and a resident of 1 Progreso St., Barangay 4, San Jose, Antique, as per the Special Power of Attorney notarized on August 15, 2023.

It further alleges that the petitioner is the biological mother of the minor Erin Sofiya Delos Santos Molina who was born in Antique Medical Center, San Jose, Antique, on December 28, 2013. The private respondent is the biological father of Erin Sofiya. On December 30, 2013, the petitioner caused the registration of daughter's Certificate of Live Birth before the Municipal Civil Registrar of San Jose, Antique. In the said Certificate of Live Birth, the petitioner indicated the following data, viz:

Name of Child : Erin Sofiya Delos Santos Molina  
 Name of Mother: Gina Clemente Delos Santos  
 Name of Father : Eric Gomez Molina  
 Date and Place of Marriage of Parents: June 15, 2013, San Jose, Antique

Thus, it appears in the Certificate of Live Birth of Erin Sofiya that the petitioner and private respondent Eric Gomez Molina were married.

Petitioner, however, claimed that her marriage to the private respondent was not registered with the Office of the Civil Registrar General, because she was still legally married to Adeil Amin El Gamal as shown by the Certificate of Marriage with Registry No. 04-195 of the Municipal Civil Registrar of San Jose, Antique. Thus, the entries in the Certificate of Live Birth (Registry No. 2014-122) Item No. 20a and 20b of Erin Sofiya do not reflect the truth about her marriage for she had a subsisting marriage at the time of their wedding.

The petitioner, therefore, prays that the entries in the Certificate of Live Birth of Erin Sofiya be corrected by deleting the entries "June 15, 2013" and "San Jose, Antique" under Items No. 20a and 20b (Date and Place of Marriage of Parents). Erin Sofiya has been using the Certificate of Live Birth (Registry No. 2014-122), issued by the Municipal Civil Registry of San Jose, Antique, in all her public and private official transactions. Thus, the Certificate of Live Birth (Registry No. 2014-122) issued by the Municipal Civil Registry of San Jose, Antique, should be corrected to reflect that Erin Sofiya Delos Santos Molina's parents are not married to each other and can therefore be considered an ILLEGITIMATE child of her parents. The petitioner further prays that Erin Sofiya be allowed to continue using the surname "Molina" because her biological father acknowledged and continues to acknowledge her as his daughter.

The petition, being sufficient in form and substance, is hereby set for hearing on **February 27, 2025 at 8:30 o'clock in the morning** at the session hall of this Court, Justice Calixto Zaldivar Hall of Justice, Brgy. 5, Binirayan Hills, San Jose, Antique, at which time and place any interested party may appear and show cause why the petition should not be granted.

Let a copy of this Order be published once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in the **News Express**, a newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Antique. Further, let a copy of this Order be furnished the Local Civil Registrar of San Jose, Antique, the Civil Registrar General, the Solicitor General, the Provincial Prosecutor of Antique, the petitioner and her counsel, Atty. Dhelma Flor Dizen-Balestramon.

## Iloilo provincial gov't kicks off Zero Waste Month

 The Iloilo Provincial Government through the Provincial Government Environment and Natural Resources Office (PGENRO) kicked off the Zero Waste Month celebration on January 6, 2025. The month-long celebration in January

promotes the 5Rs Movement of waste management such as reduce, reuse, recycle, repurpose, and rot which aims to raise awareness in proper waste reduction.

Aside from 5Rs Movement, the Zero Waste Month also features the conduct of the province-wide Limpyo Dalanon.

As part of Zero Waste Month, PGENRO will be holding a 5Rs Hinun-anon and Solid Waste Management (SWM) demonstration in Iloilo Province from January 13 to 17.

Additionally, PGENRO will monitor and evaluate proper SWM compliance from January 20 to 26, in line with the Kasadyahan sa Kabanwahanan 2025 celebration.

A learning session and benchmarking of SWM technologies and facilities will take place on January 31. It will feature the "Tapon to Ipon Project" which collects and recycles clear PET bottles through hubs in different municipalities, in partnership with Coca-Cola Beverages Philippines, Inc. (CCBPI).

Another is the Balik Alat Program that aims to replace single-use plastics and revive the use of environment friendly handwoven baskets. Out of 43 local government units (LGUs), 38 have ordinances regulating single-use plastic use.

The province also practices "Trash in a Bottle" which is an alternative recycling method for plastic.

Meanwhile, the month of January was declared as the National Zero Waste Month under the National Presidential Proclamation No. 760 which was issued on May 5, 2014.

to be endorsed, carried and supported, in any means, by any of the participating tribes of the 2025 Kasadyahan and Dinagyang Festivals

d. To ensure that there will be no political colors during the said festivities

Treñas stressed that political campaign paraphernalia and activities have no place in this religious and socio-cultural event.

He also emphasized that the said EO ensured that political tarpaulins are no longer displayed near our judging area to ensure that the religious festivities shall not be painted with any political color.

"This step keeps the Dinagyang Festival focused on its true essence—a display of the Ilonggos' unwavering faith, vibrant culture and an inclusive sense of community, free from political influences," said Treñas.

starting with the opening salvo of the Kasadyahan sa Kabanwahanan and the Dinagyang on Jan. 9 and 10, respectively, wherein participating tribes from both cultural events will give a sneak peak of their final performances slated on Jan. 25 and 26.

The eight teams participating for the Ati Tribes competition include the Tribu Pan-ay of Fort San Pedro National High School who will try to defend its title this year, Tribu Paghidaet (La Paz NHS), Tribu Salognon (Jaro NHS), Tribu Parianon (Iloilo City NHS), Tribu Ilonganon (Jalandoni Memorial NHS), Tribu Hangaway (Graciano Lopez Jaena ES), Tribu Pag-asa kang Manduryaw (Mandurriao NHA), and Tribu Molave (Barangay San Rafael, Mandurriao).

While the nine municipalities participating in this year's Kasadyahan

sa Kabanwahanan include Cabatuan (Tinuom Festival); Leon (Kaing Festival); Maasin (Tultugan Festival); Igaras (Tangyan Festival); Anilao (Banaag Festival); New Lucena (Cry of Jellicuon Festival); and San Rafael (Tawili Festival). Each group also received P2 million subsidy from the provincial government.

On the other hand, as part of the safety and security preparation during the festival, the Police Regional Office (PRO)-6 is set to deploy 2,000 security personnel for the duration of the festivities as the Iloilo City Police Office (ICPO) continues to discuss with the organizers for additional security measures to ensure the safe conduct of the events.

The ICPO also sent a formal request for signal jamming to the Iloilo City Government, specifically targeting high-density areas during peak festival times, but the plan is still under

discussion. In 2024, the ICPO also requested for blocking of mobile signals, but it was denied by the city government.

Meanwhile, tickets for the 2025 Dinagyang Festival and Kasadyahan Festival competitions can now be purchased online as the IFFI introduced a new ticketing system that aims to make it easier for locals, balikbayans, and tourists to secure seats for the highly anticipated cultural events.

Tickets are available at [dinagyangtickets.com](http://dinagyangtickets.com) for two judging areas: Quezon-Ledesma and Mabini-Delgado, wherein buyers can purchase up to 10 tickets per transaction by providing the names of attendees.

Tickets for the Dinagyang Festival are priced at P2,500 for gold tier and P2,000 for silver tier, while Kasadyahan Festival tickets can be bought at P1,200 for gold tier and P700 for silver tier. (PIA Iloilo)

# NGCP marks fruitful 2024, eyes completion of key projects soon

Several milestones marked NGCP's achievements in 2024, following the completion of four major grid projects that have significantly bolstered the reliability of the country's grid infrastructure.

In January, NGCP inaugurated the Mindanao-Visayas Interconnection Project (MVIP), the Cebu-Negros-Panay 230-kiloVolt (kV) backbone in April, and the Mariveles-Hermosa-San Jose 500kV Line in July.

Capping its fruitful year, NGCP also fully completed the Cebu-Bohol Interconnection Project last September. The CBIP plays a crucial role in improving transmission services and grid stability in Central Visayas and helps develop the transmission highway in Cebu, the load center of Visayas, through a new line that will transmit power in and out of the province.

"These achievements reflect NGCP's strong commitment to advancing our grid infrastructure to ensure a more stable and resilient power supply for households, businesses, and industries," NGCP said.

Aside from the completion of big-ticket projects, NGCP provided better service at a lower cost, charging

only P0.55 centavos per KWH, compared to P0.74 under TransCo. The amount is equivalent to just 3.39 percent of the electricity bill, while generation and distribution charges make up its bulk with 53.17 percent and 21.81 percent, respectively.

Since NGCP took over the transmission operations from TransCo in 2009, outages went down by 82 percent, reflecting the significant improvement in the efficiency and reliability of the country's grid under its watch.

Amid the successful year, NGCP is not resting on its laurels as it intends to complete more projects in the coming years, including the New Antipolo 230kV Substation in Rizal, Laguindingan 230kV Substation in Misamis Oriental, and substation upgrading, voltage improvement, and reliability projects in Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.

Other projects scheduled for completion, barring any further right-of-way, permitting, and other external delays, include the Tuguegarao-Lal-lo (Magapit) 230kV Transmission Line, Ambuklao-Binga-San Manuel 230kV Line, Western Luzon 500kV Backbone Stage 2,

Marilao Extra High Voltage Substation, Tuy 500/230 kV Project Stage 1, Nabas-Caticlan-Boracay 138kV Line, Cebu-Lapu Lapu 230kV Transmission Line, Lapu Lapu 230kV Substation Project, Tacurong-Kalamansig 69 kV Transmission Line Project, and other upgrading projects.

"Despite challenges being encountered in right-of-way acquisition and permitting, with the support of relevant government agencies, we are optimistic that we are on track to finish these projects in the pipeline," said NGCP.

The transmission grid operator renewed its appeal for the swift resolution and approval of applications filed with the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC), which affects the company's operations. As a highly regulated entity, NGCP needs the ERC's approval to implement its projects and to recover the costs spent in building these transmission facilities.

"We remain hopeful that the ERC will support our efforts by ensuring a timely and fair recovery for our capital expenditure. This recovery is vital to sustaining our investment in enhancing the reliability and capacity of our energy infrastructure," NGCP remarked.



## Antique's 1,770 poor families graduate from 4Ps

SAN JOSE, Antique (PIA) — The Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) ended 2024 with good news with the graduation of 1,770 poor households to self-sufficient families.

DSWD Provincial Link Jeffrey G. Gabucay shared gratitude and delight that more families are responding proactively to the program and making the most of their grants to uplift their families' well-being.

Department of Social Welfare and Development program ANI or the 4Ps Kilos-Unlad Graduation held last December

10-20, 2024 featured the journey of more than 1,700 families from Antique who ended their journey as Pantawid Pamilya beneficiaries.

DSWD- 4Ps Social Welfare Officer Mell Joy P. Braga said that the 4Ps Kilos-Unlad Graduation is an annual activity conducted for the households exiting the program due to improved level of well-being (Self-Sufficient/Level 3) and households with no eligible child for Client Verification (CV) monitoring as certified by RPMO (Natural Attrition).

These households were turned over to the Local Government Unit for post-support services intervention to sustain their well-being upon exit and keep them from backsliding into poverty.

Of the 1,770 who exited the program last year, 1,072 have reached a self-sufficient level of well-being, while 698 were not eligible because their children had already reached the age not allowed for monitoring.

Judith D. Española, one of the graduated beneficiaries from the municipality of Tibiao, said that she is now harvesting the fruit of their hard work and perseverance, assisted by the cash grants they received from the program.

"I am very grateful for the DSWD 4Ps, now I have two licensed professional teachers and two college graduates with a degree in BS Information Technology," she said.

A political cartoonist for The Washington Post quit her job after her work – a sketch depicting Jeff Bezos, Mark Zuckerberg, and other media and technology bigwigs kneeling and holding up bags of money before a statue of former President and President-elect Donald Trump – was rejected.

The cartoon also showed Mickey Mouse on the ground. Disney Company owns ABC News, which recently reached a \$15-million settlement with Trump. The former and incoming President had sued the network for reporting on his sexual abuse trial in New York.

On Friday, Pulitzer Prize-winning artist Ann Telnaes said that this was the first time she “had a cartoon killed because of who or what I chose to aim my pen at.”

Bezos, one of the moguls in her cartoon, owns The Post.

The newspaper, founded in 1877 and which became famous for its coverage of the Watergate Scandal in the 1970s that eventually led to the resignation of President Richard Nixon, denied that Telnaes’ cartoon had been rejected for its message.

Editorial page editor David Shipley said in a

statement that “the only bias was against repetition.”

They had already published a column on the same topic, Shipley said, and another one, a satire, was also due to be published. The rejection of Telnaes’ cartoon was not due to any “malign force,” it explained.

The Post’s slogan is “Democracy dies in darkness.”

The paper’s statement on the matter could easily be confirmed by looking at columns that purport to address the same issue. It might also be that it pulled its punches because the cartoon could be seen as an articulation of an institutional position, not only the views of one writer or cartoonist.

But what are the rules, really, in toeing the editorial line when it conflicts with the practical demands of ownership? Ultimately, is the press freer on some issues than on others? Would a satire be exempt from the rules?

Unfortunately, the ideals of journalism often run counter to what journalists contend with from day to

day. Realities such as politics, economics, and personal issues, even, could color a news organization’s practices and preferences vis-a-vis the profession’s lofty ideals. As a result, freedom is in fact uneven – something purists and idealists may find difficult to accept. The sooner we acknowledge this imperfection, the higher our chances are of pushing for “what should be” despite the odds, instead of being defeated by “what is”.

Anywhere in the world, ownership of media enterprises is driven by a host of factors. Meanwhile, it is incumbent upon journalists to keep pushing and testing boundaries. Stark realities notwithstanding, we know that the powerful forces in media are aware of the sheer power that their enterprise holds in shaping the nation. We continue to hope that despite their other interests, they continue to hold themselves responsible for the pursuit of the higher public good. They would not be so crass or tyrannical as to suppress a freedom we so cherish, and upon which our democratic society rests. ([manilastandard.net](http://manilastandard.net))

## Math

Two days ago, a team of students from the Philippines emerged as the overall champion in the World International Mathematical Olympiad (WIMO) finals in Shenzhen, China. The team collectively won 10 gold, 10 silver and 20 bronze medals in different events and categories. The team continued the string of successful stints of Team Philippines in the annual math Olympiad. The Philippine team collected 14 gold medals from last year's Math Olympiad held in Malaysia.

Despite several studies showing that Filipino kids in general are not as adept in math as other students in Asia, the stellar performance of the kids of Team Philippines in recent world math competition shows that Filipino kids have the potential to compete with the world's best in math.

For most Filipino students and adults, math is not exactly a popular subject. As kids, we often joke about our general disdain for math which we often retain until adulthood. A few months ago, I bought some pieces of bread from a small bakery. The store was temporarily under the care of the 15-year-old son of the

owner who apparently had a hard time calculating my change because his phone was dead and he did not have a calculator. I was stunned when I realized that he could not do basic subtraction manually. Recently, I was lecturing a group of campaign leaders on the mathematical components of any election strategy such as command vote calculation, survey number extrapolation and application, pareto principle, and other related concepts. In the middle of the lecture, one of the leaders asked if they really needed numbers to run a campaign. I asked them how they can gauge their progress and they answered that they can "feel" the progress.

There is no denying that math is essential for many things. In business, politics and even everyday life, you will need math and numbers. Unfortunately, we seem to develop a certain dislike for math even at an early age. How do we get more kids or even adults to love math? There is an old joke that one way to make numbers interesting is to put a peso or dollar sign near it. Perhaps there is a kernel of wisdom to that joke. By linking math to things of interest to individuals,

we can make math relevant to people. Let us take the aforementioned incident with the campaign team. When I showed how numbers can be an integral tool in politics, the eyes of the campaign team lit up with infinite possibilities of application. There is a Filipino Canadian TikTok sensation who gained popularity by explaining complex math concepts in the simplest terms possible within 60 seconds, and he does it in drag and in a most entertaining way.

We can start getting kids interested in math early by tweaking how we teach math. Technology, games, humor and various entertainment modes are readily available for math teachers to get kids into math. All we need are more trailblazers and pioneers to get this going. Let us make math cool for the kids and maybe we can increase math skills for our younger generation.

## The green leap of QC – Transitioning to electric buses

Quezon City has once again taken a significant step for the environment and its residents by recently rolling out six brand-new electric buses as part of its *Libreng Sakay* program. These electric buses complement the 90 existing buses currently servicing various routes in Quezon City, providing free and sustainable transportation for QC citizens.

In addition to being eco-friendly, the electric buses have a seating capacity of 41 passengers and additional standing room for commuters. To ensure passenger safety, they feature air-conditioning, Wi-Fi, CCTV cameras, handrails, and fire suppression systems. The buses are also persons with disabilities or PWD-friendly, featuring wheelchair ramps for accessibility.

Quezon City is the only city in the Philippines offering free bus rides to its constituents, making transportation more accessible and affordable for its residents. Now, the city is pioneering electric buses, further cementing its commitment to sustainability and public welfare. The introduction of electric buses not only contributes to reducing air pollution and improving the city's environmental footprint but also ensures that residents continue to enjoy free rides – a much-needed benefit, especially in the face of rising transportation costs. This forward-thinking initiative positions Quezon City as a leader in eco-friendly and inclusive urban mobility.

This initiative of the Quezon City government aligns with the Electric Vehicle Industry Development Act (EVIDA), also known as Republic Act 11697, which mandates that local government units (LGUs) integrate at least 5 percent of electric vehicles (EVs) into their fleets. Signed into law in April 2022, EVIDA establishes a comprehensive policy framework to promote the adoption of EVs and foster a sustainable EV industry in the Philippines. Central to the law is the formulation of the Comprehensive Roadmap for the Electric Vehicle Industry (CREVI), which sets the foundation for EV infrastructure, standards, and support systems. The law offers incentives, such as tax breaks and exemptions to manufacturers, importers, and users of EVs. It also requires commercial and government fleets to meet minimum EV quotas and mandates the installation of charging

stations in parking areas and other strategic locations. By reducing dependence on fossil fuels, cutting greenhouse gas emissions, and advancing sustainable transportation, EVIDA aims to build a cleaner and more eco-friendly future for the country.

LGUs have yet to fully implement the new law. However, the global trend is shifting toward the adoption of electric buses, driven by the urgent need to address climate change. The increasing use of electric buses reflects a growing recognition of the importance of eco-friendly transportation, especially in the face of global warming, which has exacerbated extreme weather events like typhoons, impacting many countries worldwide.

Electric buses first gained prominence in China, and within a few years, other countries began adopting the technology. In Europe, electric bus registrations increased by 48 percent in 2021 compared to 2020, and the market continued to grow, expanding by 26 percent in 2022. Globally, the use of electric buses has become a significant trend, reflecting the push toward cleaner and more sustainable public transportation.

China's highly supportive government policies have positioned the country as the world's largest market for electric buses, accounting for more than 95 percent of the global stock. At the end of 2022, BBC News reported that China's Ministry of Transport classified over three-quarters (77 percent or 542,600) of all urban buses in the country as "new energy vehicles." This term encompasses pure electric, plug-in hybrids, and fuel cell vehicles powered by alternative fuels, such as hydrogen and methanol. Notably, 84 percent of China's new energy bus fleet in 2022 consisted of purely electric vehicles.

Electric buses are rapidly becoming the preferred choice for road mass transportation, offering numerous benefits that make them an attractive solution to urban transportation challenges.

One of the most significant advantages is the environmental impact. Electric buses produce zero tailpipe emissions, which greatly reduces air pollution and improves air quality in cities. Additionally, they contribute to the fight against climate change by lowering greenhouse gas emissions.

## FRESH VIEWPOINTS: A NEW PERSPECTIVE

From an economic perspective, electric buses are cost-effective in the long term. While their initial purchase price is higher than diesel buses, the operating costs are significantly lower due to cheaper electricity and reduced maintenance requirements. Furthermore, the development of electric bus infrastructure and manufacturing can generate employment opportunities across various sectors.

The health benefits of electric buses are equally compelling. By reducing air pollution, they help improve respiratory health for urban residents. Moreover, their quieter operation compared to diesel buses results in less noise pollution, creating a more pleasant and livable urban environment.

Electric buses also drive technological advancements. Their adoption promotes innovation in areas, such as battery technology, charging infrastructure, and smart city solutions. Additionally, they are more energy-efficient, converting a higher percentage of stored energy into movement compared to internal combustion engines.

There are significant social benefits as well. Electric buses improve the public transportation experience by offering modern features, such as Wi-Fi, air conditioning, and accessibility for persons with disabilities. Additionally, they promote greater awareness of sustainability, encouraging communities to adopt more eco-friendly practices.

Quezon City is on the right track in pioneering the implementation of the Electric Vehicle Industry Development Act (EVIDA), aligning itself with the global shift toward electric buses. As the city embraces this eco-friendly transportation solution, it is setting an example for other major Philippine cities to follow. This move not only supports green technology but also contributes to a more sustainable, environmentally friendly mass transport system. Adopting electric buses is a crucial step toward a safer environment for future generations, as the world commits to reducing carbon emissions. We hope that more cities in the Philippines will embrace this change, helping create a cleaner, greener future for all.

**Section 4** – Use of Savings and Augmentation – In accordance with Section 336 of Republic Act No. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991, the Mayor and the Presiding Officer of the Sanggunian are authorized to augment any item in the approved annual budget for their respective offices from savings in other

items within the same expense class of their respective appropriations.

For this purpose, "Savings" refer to portions or balances of any programmed appropriation free from any obligation or encumbrance, still available after the satisfactory completion or the unavoidable discontinuance or abandonment of the work, activity or purpose for which the appropriation is authorized, or arising from unpaid compensation and related costs pertaining to vacant positions and leaves of absence without pay.

"Augmentation" implies the existence in the budget of an item, project, activity or purpose with an appropriation which, upon implementation or subsequent evaluation of needed resources, is determined to be deficient.

**Section 5.** Priority in the use of Personal Services Savings – Priority shall be given to the personnel benefits of local employees in the use of Personal Services Savings.

**Section 6.** Separability Clause – If, for any reason, any section or provision of this Appropriation Ordinance is disallowed in Budget Review or declared invalid by proper authorities, other sections or provisions hereof that are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**Section 7.** Effectivity – The provisions of this Appropriation Ordinance shall take effect on January 01, 2024.
